Basic doors, frames and hardware

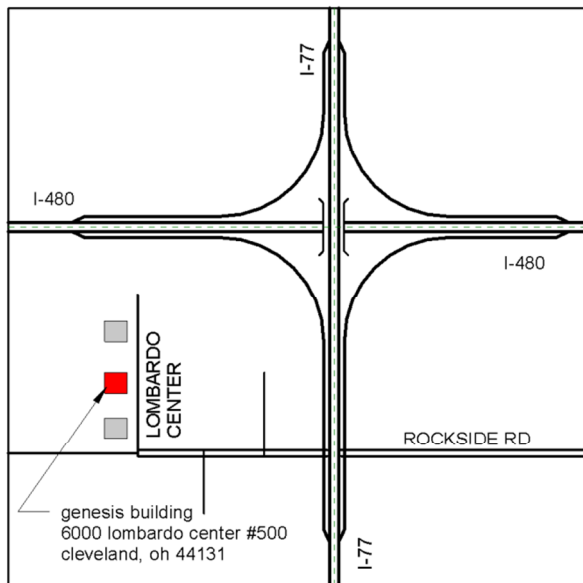
